

Hi, is _____ there? I'm _____ with Worker Power and I'm here because there are a few very important votes on your March election ballot. **Measure HLA** will make our streets **safer** and **reduce traffic**. **Councilmember Nithya Raman** is a key supporter of Measure HLA. She also built housing, decreased rents, and improved healthcare for Angelinos. - c. **Clean candidate:** Councilmember Raman is the only candidate in the race who has pledged not to take money from real estate developers, corporations, and fossil fuel companies.
- d. **“What has she done about homelessness?”** Councilmember Raman fought to build shelters that got unhoused folks off the street, decreasing the number of people sleeping on the street in the district for the first time since 2016. She's closed numerous encampments by helping those living there find housing.
